Scouts To Hear rresident Roosevelt

Speaking as the Honorary Presilent of the Boy Scouts of America which he has been an active lead er for more than sixteen years, President Roosevelt will make radio address to the nation's 1,500, 000 Boy Scouts, Cubs, Senior Scouts and leaders on Sarutday evening, Feb. 8 at 7:30 p. m. EST.

His address will be the highlight of Boy Scout Week, Feb. 7 to 13, marking the 31st anniversary of the founding of the Boy Scout Movement in the United States. It will be the ninth message President Roosevelt has addressed to the Boy Scouts. Since entering the White House he has participated in each Boy Scout Weew observance. also spoke by radio to Scouts August, 1935, in connection with the forced cancellation of the first National Boy Scout Jamboree.

Participating in the broadcast with President Roosevelt, which will be carried by the Red Network of the National Broadcasting Co. and the Columbia and Mutual Networks will be Walter W. Head of St. Louis President of the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America, and Dr. James E. West, Chief Scout Executive.
