Now, raports in defense offices show, the big companies are subcontracting volumes of work to smaller concerns. No less an author ity than the office of the Assistant Secretary of War reports that 50 percent of all contracts for munttions have been sublet.

The price of the dust ranges from 50 to 70 cents ped lb. Extension Service. It is used at the rate of 3 ounces of 2 percent Ceresan per bushel of seed, or 1 1.2 ounces of 5 per cent dust per bushel of seed. Hence, the cost will range from 9 to 14 cents per bushel for 2 percent Ceresan and from 5 to 8 cents per bushel for 5 percent Ceresan.


Q.-What grazing crops are suitable for swine?
