Lutherans Launch Drive For Funds For Men In Training Camps

The Lutheran congregation of St. Matthews launched a drive last Sunday to raise funds which will be used to help support a comprehensive program of service in behalf of Lutheran men in army and navy training camps according to the announcement of Rev. H. G. Fisher, Pastor. Virtually all Lutheran congregations in the United States are cooperating in this appeal.

A committee consisting of A. S. Kiser, A. S. Bennett, D. C. Mauney and W. K. Mauney, which will be in charge of this work assisted by the Pastor, was appointed. Particular emphasis will be given to the fact that this is also a means of honoring mothers by ministering to their sons and that all who contribute will thereby honor the mothers of the Church on Mother's Day. The appeal, therefore, will be climaxed, and, if possible concluded, on Mother's Day, Sunday May 11th. Though some solicitations may continue after that date all reports will be made by June 1st.


Altogether about 14,000 Lutheran congregations throughout the nation are supporting this ministry to trainees.
