**Farm Questions**

Q—How will cotton marketing change next year?  
A—Marketing agencies will work the same this year as they did under last year's AAA program, says E. V. Floyd, state AAA executive director at State College. Overplanted farmers will get red cards; farmers who have planted within allotments will get white cards. The penalty for selling excess cotton this year will be seven cents a pound, last year's penalty was three cents a pound.  
Q—What protection will the farmer get in increasing food production next year and in the future?  
A—The U. S. Department of Agriculture has set up facilities for buying and moving to consumers all emergency foods produced under the food-for-freedom program next year says Devin I. O. Schaub of State College. The department will continue to support prices of all needed food commodities except beef on the basis of at least 85 percent of parity prices. The floor and price will be continued at least through June 1942 and production will be allowed to prevent price drops after that time.
