

**Conservation Rules
Announced By Floyd**

Rates of payment for planting within special crop allotments under the 1942 Agricultural Conservation Program of the AAA have been announced, according to E. Y. Floyd, State AAA executive assistant at State College.

The rates and other provisions of the program, explains Mr. Floyd, are "directed at greater conservation achievements on individual farms and at helping farmers attain record production of farm products needed under the Farm Defense Program."

Payment rates, except for commercial wheat, are somewhat lower than in 1941. The rates include one and one-quarter cents per pound for cotton; 10 and one-half cents per bushel for commercial wheat; \$1.45 per ton for peanuts; two cents per pound for commercial potatoes; 74¢ of a cent per pound for hay and

Payment rates for complying with acreage allotments will be made in ratios to the degree to which soil usage goals are carried out on the farm.


