Highway and Public Works Commission started today

Following the policy of former years, maps will be sent larger to towns, touring bureaus, chambers of commerce, touring bureaus of metropolitan newspapers and other agencies disbursing travel information.

The 1942 map has been fully corrected to include highways on which construction work is scheduled to be completed by next summer. The face of the folded map pictures the state capitol building while on the back is a brief description of principal points of interest in every section of the state.

On the reverse side of the map are twelve pictures representing scenes from the three main sections of the state. Western North Carolina is represented by a striking picture of the state's fourteenth tower in a month that overlooks the capitol building on the state of the Blue Ridge Parkway near Waynesville. Another section of the Parkway on the completed section near the Gap is also pictured.

Other Land of the Sky pictures are the Looking Glass Falls located on Highway 276 in the Pisgah National Forest near Brevard and Grandfather Mountain rugged peak of the Blue Ridge system located near Linville.

Central North Carolina is represented by an interior view of a tobacco warehouse, a happy negro baby seated on a cotton pile, a herd of dairy cattle in a farm lane and a Spring-like view of one of the Sand hills golf courses.

Coastal pictures include the Wright Memorial Tulip fields at Terra Ceia Dutch Colony near Washington the Spanish moss overhanging the highway near Wrightsville Beach and a surf fisherman casting for channel bass.

Though the policy has been to curtail map distribution in Nevada, West Virginia and other states, material supplied on North Carolina highway maps has not been considered as yet strategic enough in nature to hold.
