

NORTH CAROLINA WEEKLY WAR BOUND UP

Ceilings Extended - Temporary price ceilings on eggs, poultry and manufactured dairy products have been extended until January 3, the North Carolina Office of Price Administration announced.

Idle Tire Turn-ins - More than 100,000 tires have been received by the Charlotte district office of the Defense Supplies Corporation under the Idle Tire Purchase Plan.

Blackout Curtains - With surprise blackouts likely to come at any moment the State Office of Civilian Defense urged this week that blackout curtains be provided in homes where there are open fireplaces.

Jobs For War Needs - Confidential positions in the war department are open to intelligent women and to alert men with 4-F draft classification.

Restricted Areas Marked - Aerial attack on the North Carolina coast under wartime restriction are being marked by the Coast Guard in cooperation with the OGD.

Air Raid Books - In cooperation with the State Industrial Commission, the OGD has distributed more than 2,000 books of instructions to air raid protection to schools throughout the State.

December Quotas - North Carolina has been assigned a quota of 700,000 passenger cars for December by the State of A. announced.

Students Name Ship - The Royal Navy's new ship, the H.M.S. "Plover," has been named in honor of the State-wide school scrap drive.

How To Handle Bombs - Instruction in handling delayed-action and unexploded bombs is being given by the Army in schools sponsored by the OGD.

Cotton Quotas Vote Set For December 12

North Carolina cotton producers will join with others over the Cotton Belt on Saturday, Dec. 12, in a referendum on marketing quotas for the 1943-44 marketing year according to G. T. Scott, chairman of the State AAA Committee.

Cotton marketing quotas are provided in the Agricultural Adjustment Act of 1938 under which the Secretary of Agriculture must proclaim quotas in any year in which the cotton supply reaches more than 107 percent of the normal supply.

two years supply of cotton on hand but a larger than usual part of this supply is composed of shorter staples and lower grades. Cotton producers, wherever practical, have been asked to shift production to the longer staple lengths. Quotas never have been applied to cotton of 1 1/2 inch or longer.
