

State College Hints To Farm Homemakers

(Both Current, N. C. State College)

When stewing dried fruits, the addition of a small amount of lemon or orange juice and a bit of lemon or orange rind will improve the flavor.

To save time when hanging out clothes on cold days, pin all the handkerchiefs, socks, and small pieces to wire clothes hangers before going outside to hang them. Arranged in this way, it takes only a moment to hook the hangers over the clothes line, thus saving time and fingers, both in hanging out the clothes and taking them in.

To keep potted plants from damping out or withering on window sills, use any wrap put out

and have it cut to fit the window sills.

Stopped shavers do away with shaving. Shaving shavers being equipped to the user.

It is wiser to sit at the table with feet flat on the floor than to sit on the floor with feet on the table. Pull chair out with right hand, step forward, seat self, and pull chair in place.

Remove napkin from table unrolled and place in lap to protect clothes and to wipe hands.

It saves a cent to unfasten it when sitting in it for any length of time. This wastes strain at both the hips and the shoulders and prevents stretching and sagging.

SAVE PLENTY OF LESPEDEZA SEED

Growers should save plenty of lespedeza seed this fall because the popularity of this hay crop is increasing in all sections of North Carolina and relatively large acreages will be planted in the spring, says Dr. Emerson Collins, in charge of Extension agronomy at State College.

Lespedeza is not only proving an excellent hay crop but it is also being widely used as a temporary grazing crop for both hogs and cattle. This year feed crops have been short on many farms and lespedeza has provided a backlog of grazing that has enabled many growers to pull through in good shape.

Collins notes that the grazing of hogs on lespedeza, as shown by the demonstrations conducted by Ellis Vestal, Extension swine specialist,

has enabled growers to produce some of the cheapest gains of any method of feeding. Only a small amount of corn was used and a good, nutritious supplement was kept before the hogs at all times.

The same was true for cowboys. Herds of these crops are now being wintered for temporary grazing and, in addition, provide more than one half of the hay grown in North Carolina.

With the shortage of later, livestock men are turning more and more to grazing crops as one of their chief sources of feed and lespedeza will continue to be one of the best crops for this purpose, according to Collins.
