

**JAMES MAUNEY PROMOTED**

James I. Mauney, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. I. Mauney, Route 2, was recently promoted to the grade of sergeant. It has been announced by his group commander, Lt. Col. William L. Stouder of Denver, Colo. An aerial engineer and gunner, Sgt. Mauney is stationed in Italy with a veteran Liberator bombardment group which has flown more than 175 bombing missions against strategic enemy oil, rail and industrial centers throughout central and southern Eu-

rope. Prior to entering the service on Jan. 21, 1942, Sgt. Mauney was employed by the Glenn L. Martin Co., Baltimore, Md.
