Edna Barber Is Given Discharge By Marines

Cpl. Edna Barber, son of Mr. and Mrs. George Barber, of Kings Mountain, has received an honorable discharge from the Marine Corps, following two years and one day of service in which he saw 18 months duty in the Pacific theater of operations, including the invasion of Guam.

Cpl. Barber, discharged via the medical route, arrived back in the United States on January 2. He was discharged on February 28, after receiving treatment for an ailment which has felled many soldiers in the island area—malaria due to the lungs. He described the invasion of Guam as a "not too healthy" operation and said he felt much better on U. S. soil than to be in the fighting on two Jims.
