

Semi-Pro To Have Knot-Hole Gang: Advisory Group Named

John Henry Moss, business manager of the VFW semi-pro baseball team, announced this week that a Knot-Hole gang will be organized with free tickets to the games for children up to age 14 to be distributed through Sunday Schools of the city.

Tickets will be given on an attendance-at-Sunday School basis, he said.

Otherwise, he reported that the team is shaping up nicely in its early practice sessions, which are being held each afternoon at 4 o'clock at the city stadium.

He also announced appointment of

an advisory commission representing various civic organizations of the city to aid in superintending the operations of the club. Included on the group are: H. Y. Ballard, Kiwanis club, W. L. Plonk, American Legion, Byron Keeter, Merchants, C. C. Edens, Lions club, Frank Cranford, VFW, Luke Pearson, Boosters club, W. K. Mauney, Jr., Junior Chamber of Commerce, and George C. Barber, Margrace club. Representatives from the Goodfellows club and War Dads have not yet been named.

The club will play in a six-team pre loop including Clover, Mt. Holly, Carlton Mill of Cherryville and Rex

and Hanover Mills of Gastonia. League play begins May 4, with two league games to be scheduled each week.

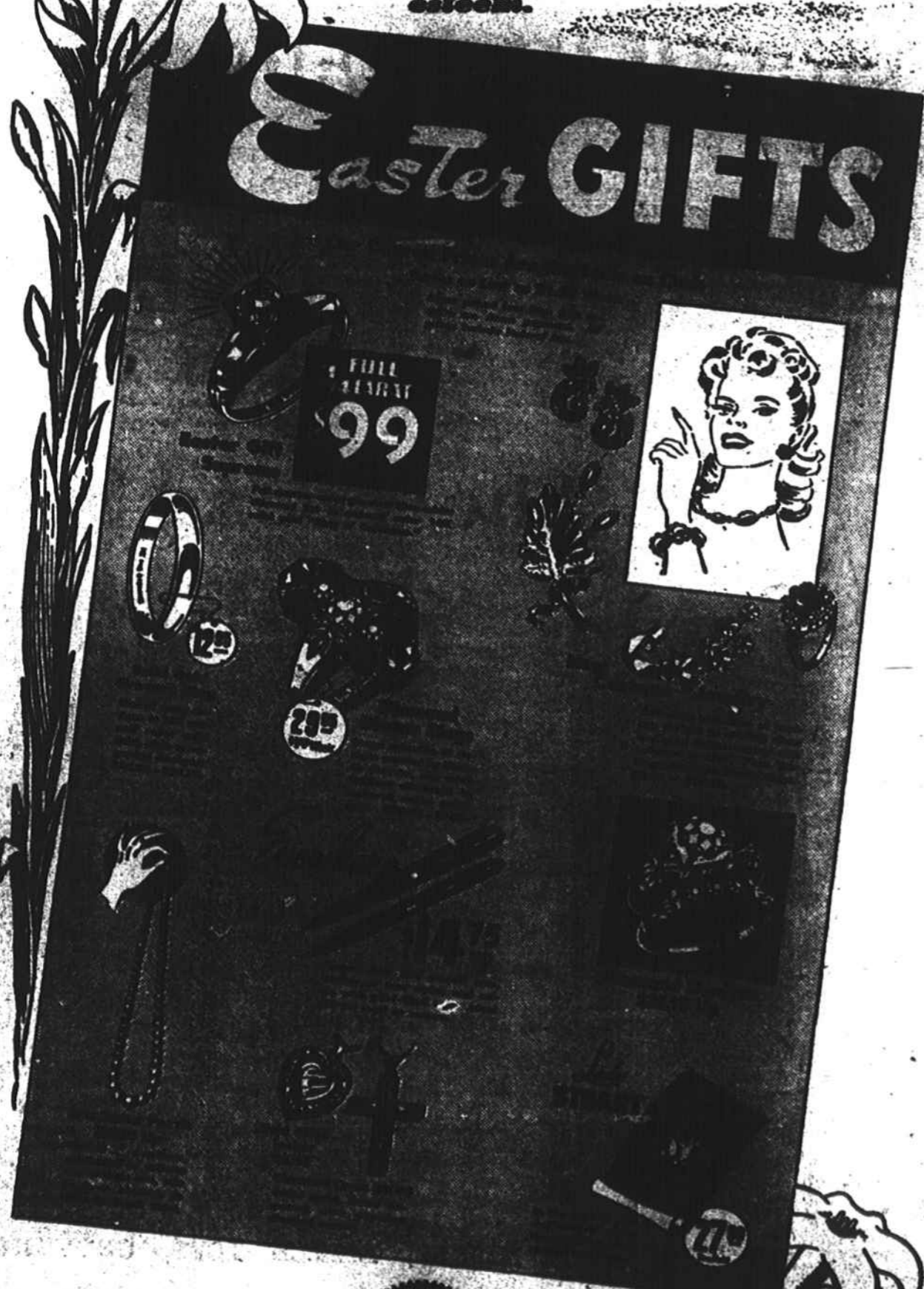

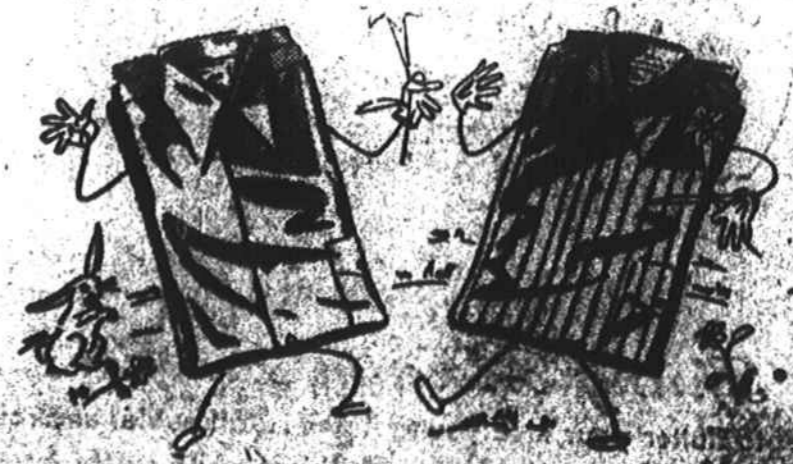
