No-Good Addresses Means Checks Returned

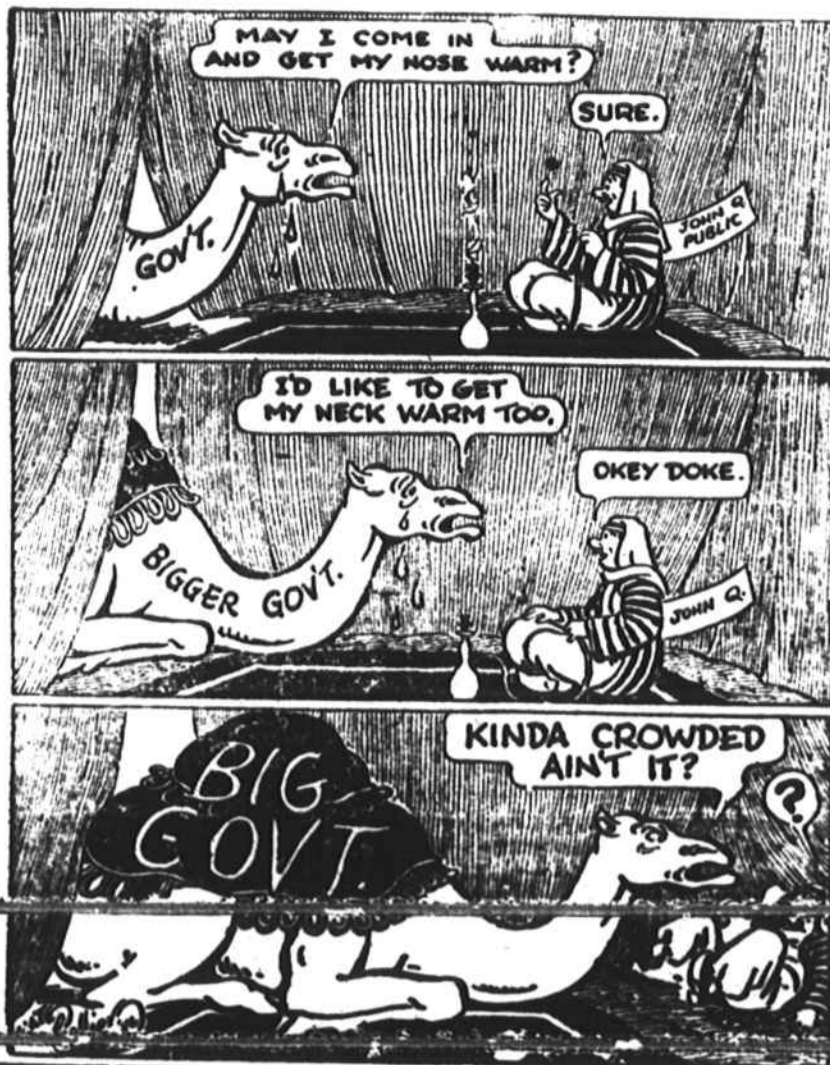
An average of 75 to 100 checks for North Carolina veterans are returned to the Treasury disbursing office every day for lack of correct forwarding addresses. Veterans going to school and those enrolled for job-training are requested to report promptly every change of address in order that delays in forwarding their checks may be avoided.

Change of addresses should be sent immediately to the Veterans Administration Regional office, Winston-Salem, N. C.

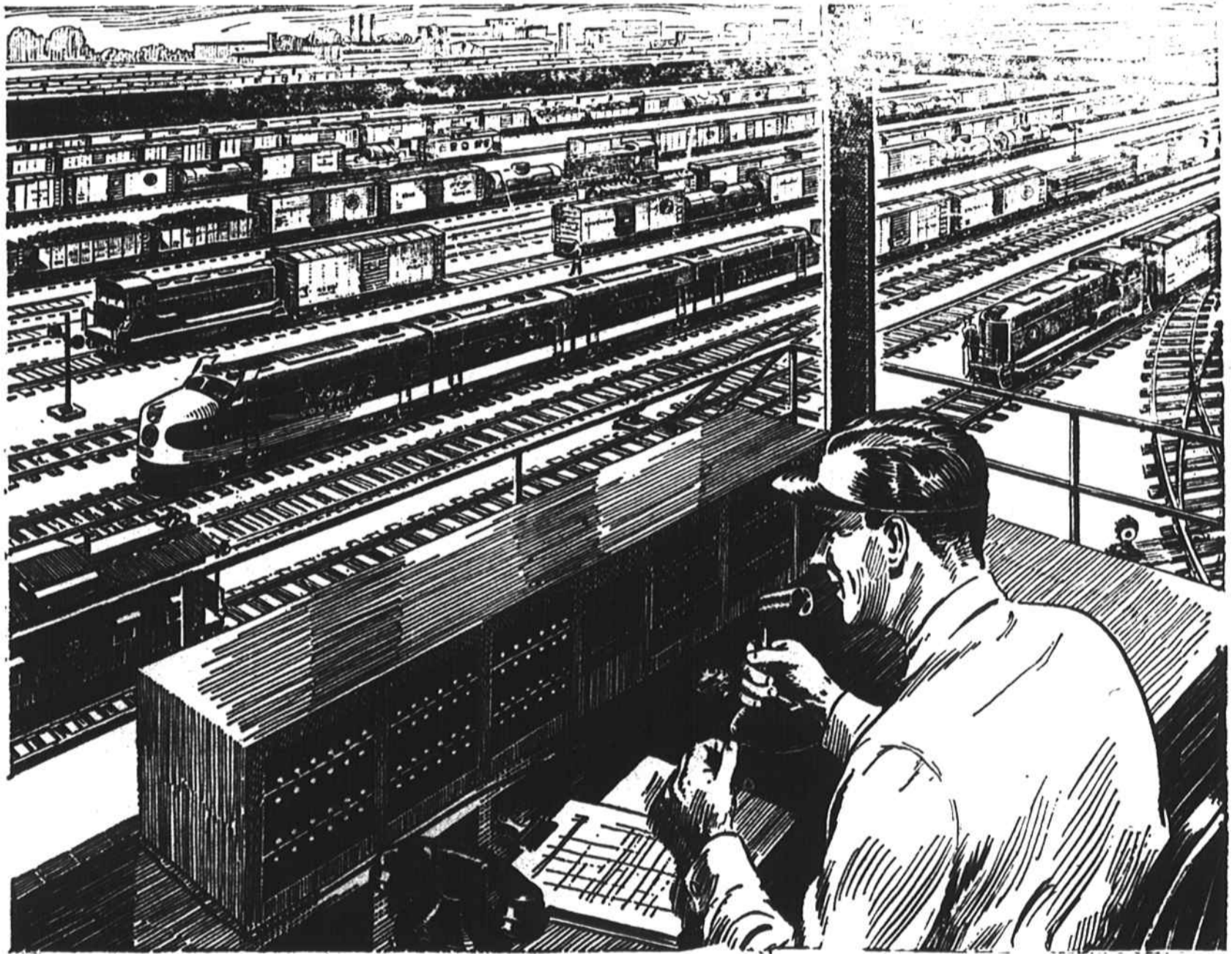
