



## No-Good Addresses Means Checks Returned

Veterans who are supposed to get subsistence allowance checks each month were warned by the Veterans Administration today that literally thousands of such checks are returned undelivered because correct mailing addresses have not been furnished the VA.

An average of 75 to 100 checks for North Carolina veterans are returned to the Treasury disbursing office every day for lack of correct forwarding addresses. Veterans going to school and those enrolled for jobtraining are requested to report promptly every change of address in order that delays in forwarding their checks may be avoided.

Change of addresses should be sent immediately to the Veterans Adminis tration Regional office, Winston-Salem, N. C.
