Installment Payments Can Be Made By Wire

Now many Kings Mountain people can make their regular payments on automobiles, refrigerators and other durable goods bought on the installment plan at the nearest Western Union office. Mrs. Arzie B. Rogers, manager of the telegraph company announced today.

General Motors Acceptance Corporation and the Commercial Credit Corporation have already subscribed to this service to provide a convenient means for their customers to pay their monthly installments. Mrs. Rogers said, and the service is expected to spread to many other companies as the public becomes aware of this convenience.

Under this plan installment payments may be made at several thousand Western Union offices in the United States. Subscribing firms, such as finance companies and other credit agencies, may give their customers coupons showing the individual account number and the amount of budget payment due. Western Union gives a receipt to the customer and forwards the remittance and coupon to the subscribing firm.

Available at Western Union offices at all hours, including Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, the service is especially convenient for people who do not have checking accounts. The fee is only 10 cents per payment.
