Central high school baseball team went hitless for 8 innings in City Stadium Tuesday night but jumped on Charlotte Tech high pitcher Francis Killian in the ninth for four runs on one hit and four bases on balls.

Bob Huffstetler, Mountaineer catcher, got credit for the lone Kings Mountain hit when Second Baseman Hasty for Tech was unable to handle his grounder between second and first with the bases loaded. Two runs came in on the blow.

Killian got in trouble after John Hopkins, at shortstop, threw wild to first on Bill Caldwell's easy hopper. The right-hander then issued two free passes to fill the bases and worked the next two men to 3-2 counts before walking them.

Don Ellison started on the mound for Kings Mountain and was touched for 12 hits and 13 runs in 8 innings. Bud Medlin took over in the ninth and held the visitors hitless.

Killian struck out 17 Mountaineers and walked 8.
