

Caution Urged In Buying Seed

Farmers should beware of buying seed claimed to be certified unless a properly signed certification tag is attached to each bag of seed, Dr. R. P. Moore, director in charge of the North Carolina Crop Improvement Association at State College, warned this week.

"If a seller of seed wishes to capitalize on the word 'Certified' he should be requested to deliver the evidence of certification in the form of a certification tag on which a signed agreement may be found," Dr. Moore asserted.

Some dealers, he continued, engage in practices which often lead to misunderstanding and the purchase of seed which under no circumstances would meet certification requirements.

"Agencies advertising certified seed, but stating or inferring that certification tags will be furnished only when requested, might sell on-

ly seed which is eligible for certification and again they may not," the Crop Improvement director explained. "Prospective buyers of certified seed should look with suspicion, however, upon seed offered by dealers of this type."

Early purchases of certified seed should be booked subject to the condition that certification requirements will be met, Dr. Moore said.

Public Welfare Board Lists Legal Solicitors

The Cooperative for American Remittances to Europe whose address is 50 Broad Street, New York, 4, N. Y., and the Church World Service with the address of 214 East 21st St., New York, 10, N. Y., are organizations licensed by the State Board of Public Welfare in conformity with provisions of the state solicitation law to appeal for clothing, commodities, and funds for distribution to either needy children or adults in foreign countries, it was announced yesterday by the State Board of Public Welfare.

In making this announcement it was explained that during recent months many citizens have inquired of the State Board of Public Welfare regarding approved organizations through which to channel their donations to needy people of other countries and, therefore, the license status of these organizations is being given to citizens of the state at this time.

In this connection it was also pointed out by Dr. Ellen Winston, Commissioner of the State Board of Public Welfare, that any solicitation made by the Save the Children Federation of 1 Madison Avenue, New York City, whether for old clothes, shoes, or funds, is in violation of the state solicitation law since this organization has not been licensed by the State Board of Public Welfare.

Local Men Lease Cherryville Plant

Farmers Are Advised To Check Fire Safety

If past experience means anything, September should be designated "Check Your Fire Extinguisher" month, Ben Jenkins, county agent for the State College Extension Service, suggested this week.

Fire hazards increase during the winter months, the Agent said, pointing out that generally favorable weather conditions following Labor

Day allow plenty of time for overhauling heating plants and for making sure that all fire protection equipment is in good order.

Mr. Jenkins said that figures released by Fire Protection Institute national safety organization, show that October fire losses in this county last year increased 37 per cent over loss totals for September. The October loss totalled nearly \$55,000, he said.

"Many of those losses could have been prevented if property owners

had taken time last September to eliminate fire hazards and to make certain that fire extinguishers and other first aid equipment were in good condition."

The County Agent listed two basic rules to keep in mind in checking extinguishers. "First, be sure it is an approved extinguisher, which means a unit that comes up to standards endorsed by Underwriters Laboratories or Factory Mutual Laboratories. Second, be sure you have the right extinguishers for the va-

rious hazards on your property. And if you're doubtful, call your County Agent.

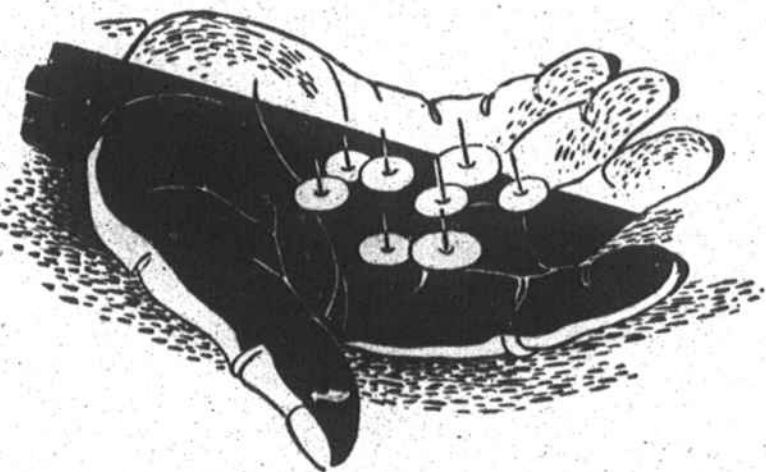
