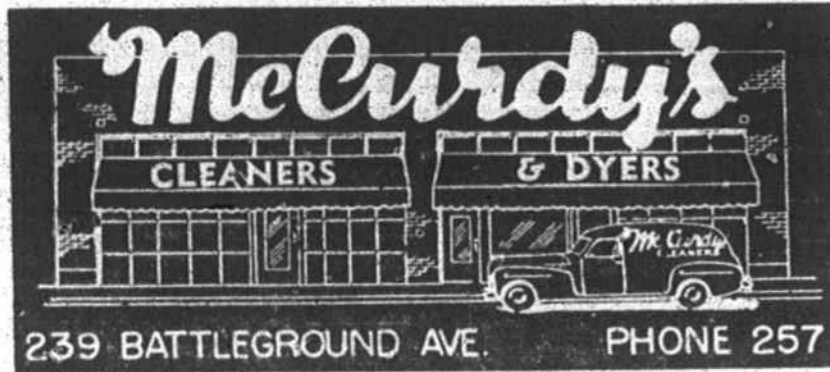

Local Churches Plan Observance Of Communion

World War veterans will be observed in all Christian churches throughout the world on Sunday, October 3, at 11 a. m.

For many years the first Sunday in October has been reserved for this special Communion service, and each year finds additional churches participating in this observance.

It is a season set aside as a tribute for a re-dedication of ourselves to the work of our Saviour, the Lord Christ. It offers the opportunity of its beauty cleansing and restoring value of forgiveness and peace. In these days of stress and tension, we need the "cleansing fountain" which the Lord offers us, and His peace for living in a tumultuous world fraught with so many dangers," said a spokesman for the Ministerial association.

This year the Ministerial Association is urging church members to join in the observance. The theme is the prayer, "Create in me a clean heart O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from Thy presence, and take not Thy Holy Spirit from me. Restore unto me, the joy of Thy Salvation, and uphold me with Thy green Spirit."

At a recent meeting of the Kings Mountain Ministerial Association, it was announced that all churches in the community would observe Communion on Oct. 3rd.

Credit Curbs Reinvoked For \$50-\$5000 Purchases

WASHINGTON, Aug. 19 (AP)—The government today clamped controls on most consumer installment credit purchases between \$50 and \$5000, effective Sept. 20. A new Federal Reserve Board regulation requires a one-third down payment on automobiles and a 20 per cent down payment on most household appliances including stoves, refrigerators, washers, radio sets, and vacuum cleaners. A time limit of 15 days for completion of the "down payment" plan was authorized by the Republican Anti-Inflation Act signed by President Truman on Monday. Charge accounts are not affected. These are presumed to be paid off currently, usually on a monthly basis. The new down-payment rules are less strict in several cases than those for the enforcer, because legislative changes are being made.

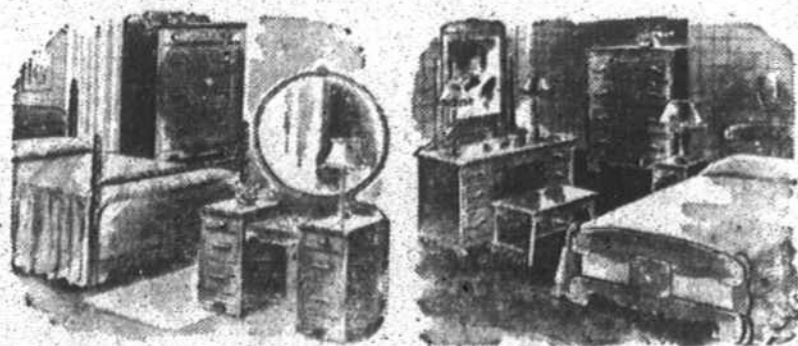

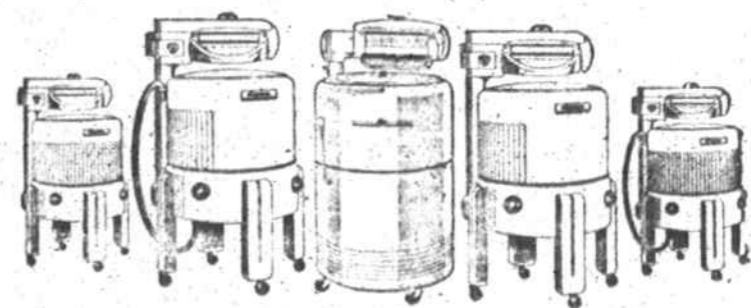
