Pigskin Pickings

Red Walker went out on the ole limb in last week's predictions to pick Pittsburg's Panthers to down highly-favored Indiana and his crystal gazing was correct. Adding the Pitt win to his remaining 30 correct forecasts, Red was again at the head of the list with 40 predictions, 31 wins, 7 wrong, two ties (Davidson 7-Wofford 7 and Michigan State 14-Penn. State 14) for a battling average of .816 for the week.

Walker's losers were Lenoir-Rhyne, W. & M., Miss. State, Yale, Columbia, Harvard, and Texas A & M. Martin Harmon saw his favorites, UNC Tar Heels, romp over LSU as he predicted but missed on 9 to fall from one-win short of Walker to three-wins short of the Redhead's record, both having predicted on the same games all season. Harmon missed on the Pitt-Indiana upset, missed on Purdue over Illinois, took

Dartmouth instead of Walker's Harvard pick, and missed on Boston College over Ole Miss. His remaining six misses were the same as Red's to give him a week's record of 40-29-9-2-763.

Sticking along with the upsets—"well I hit on Vanderbilt over Yale this week, for instance"—the Herald sports editor is as far back this stage of the season as "Beetle-Baum" was in the back-stretch. And the "almost" was Wisconsin over Ohio State, the Buckeyes finally taking the win they were highly-favored to take, the score 34 to 32 in one of the better games of the day.
