 SAN FRANCISCO.—Fashion and the French have always been synonymous in the past, but this Fall Paris can pick up a few pointers from California.
 Inspired more by French tradition and history than "haute couture" (high fashion to plain folks), California designer Stephanie Koret decided to put some famous French-

men into fashion.
 Everything from the shape of Napoleon's hat to the cuffs of the famous French Musketeer Guards, is included in Stephanie Koret's new back-to-school and on-the-job wardrobe of "Corduroy Pair-Offs."
 She chose corduroy, a top Fall favorite, because the fabric was born in France three centuries ago, when the royal tailor was commanded to create a splendid new cloth for the King's personal palace guards. He took an ordinary piece of cotton velvet and formed wefts or fillings. When he was finished, the fabric was transversely ribbed, or cotele (pronounced kote lay), as they say in French. He named it in honor of his sire, King Louis, the "corde-du-roi," cloth of kings.

All buttons in Stephanie Koret's "Corduroy Pair-Offs" are of embossed gold with a medieval coat-of-arms. Spotted through the ten-piece group, on skirts, slacks, and jackets

ars pockets with tri-cornered flaps, following the line of Napoleon's hat. A huge, free-swinging corduroy topper features generous cuffs and deeply pointed collar, both the size and cut used for uniforms of the famous King's Musketeers. The waistcoat of a French court dandy of the 18th Century, who attempted to parallel the famous Biblical "Joseph's Vest of Many Colors," is interpreted here in a tiny, rainbow-striped vestee with a slashed, plunge line and an abrupt waist cut.
 These Koret of California corduroys are integrated in new colors, richer tones, and more subtly blended ones. Gentle mocha, claret red, bluebird, and stem green and smoke grey are the important shades.

And—just to make sure that the collection was truly Californian (out of France)—Stephanie Koret added one typically California touch to the entire collection: a satin-lined, rolled-brim beanie with a saucy topknot loop!
