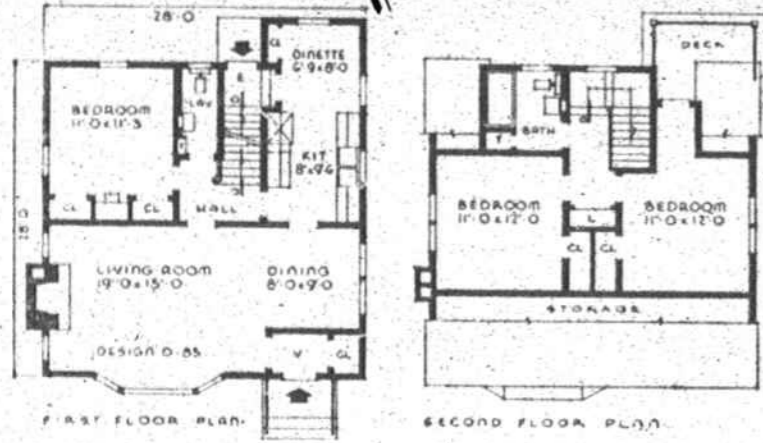
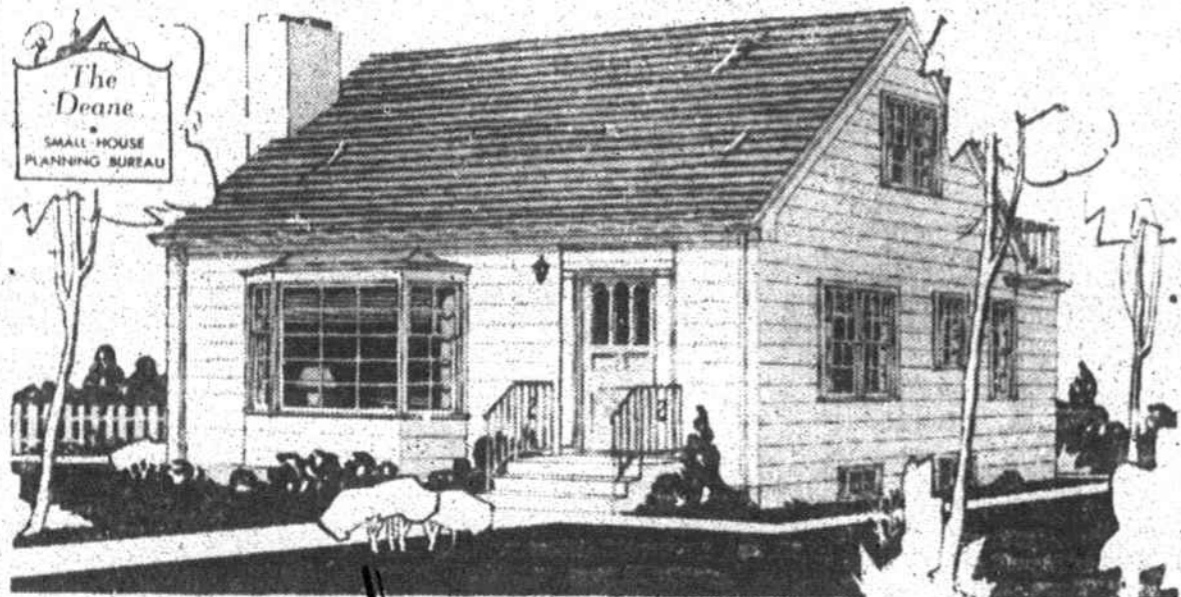


# Herald "House-of-the-Week"



**THE DEANE** is dominated by a combination living-dining room on the first floor featuring an attractive bay window and fireplace. The dining alcove is formed by the entrance vestibule and, with the bay window, adds to the size of the living-room.

Cabinets line opposite walls of the kitchen, which is located between dining room in front and den in rear.

A bedroom and adjoining lavatory complete the first floor plan. On second floor, the bath

and stairhall are in the rear dormer and two bedrooms in the gable ends. A door leads to a deck over the breakfast nook, for dusting and airing.

Frame construction is used, with wide siding, asphalt shingles, face brick chimney and full basement. Dimensions are 28 feet square. Area is 820 square feet and cubage 19,446 cubic feet.

## Four Million Pike Stocked In State

RALEIGH. — Over four million wall-eyed pike, or pike-perch, have been stocked in North Carolina water, Clyde P. Patton, executive director of the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission, announced today.

The pike fry were hatched from over 5,000,000 eggs received by the Wildlife Resources Commission from the New York State Conservation Department. The eggs were flown to Raleigh from Albany, New York, and transported directly to the Table Rock Hatchery, Morganton. Despite a short delay in transport which caused some egg mortality, George Scruggs, Superintendent of the Table Rock Hatchery, brought off an 80 percent hatch.

The pike fry were stocked in High Rock Lake, Lake James, and Lake Chatuge to determine whether these waters are suitable for wall-eyed pike habitat. Technicians of the Wildlife Resources Commission's Fish Division will make observations to determine the success of pike stocking, and future introductions will be made accordingly.

Wall-eyes are native to the French Broad, Little Tennessee and Hiwassee Rivers in North Carolina, but catches from these streams have been rare. Whenever found, the wall-eyed pike is a favorite of fishermen, being an excellent game fish and of fine texture and flavor.

According to J. H. Cornell, Chief of the Wildlife Fish Division, "the wall-eye is a fish of large waters, and shows a definite preference for low temperatures. For this reason it is not expected to compete seriously with the bass population, but rather serve as a valuable adjunct to it."
