Elasticity in this control will permit vacancies for denominations with quotas already filled. A particular need exists for alert outstanding young chaplains who would consider active duty if needed.

A. will be increased to nearly 106 million tons by the end of 1952.

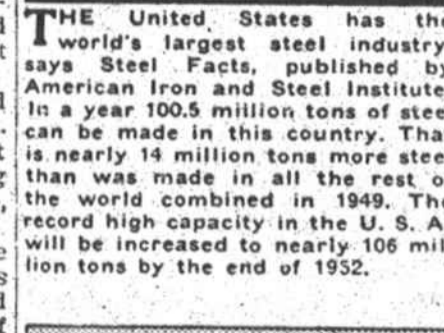


