committee. Meanwhile the House received HB 561 putting principal responsibility for investigating violent and unexplained deaths on physicians appointed by a state medical examiner and approved by a state commission on post-mortem examinations. SB 305 would permit civil actions against a city for injuries caused by negligent employees while operating its motor vehicles, though cities may still use public funds for liability insurance.
