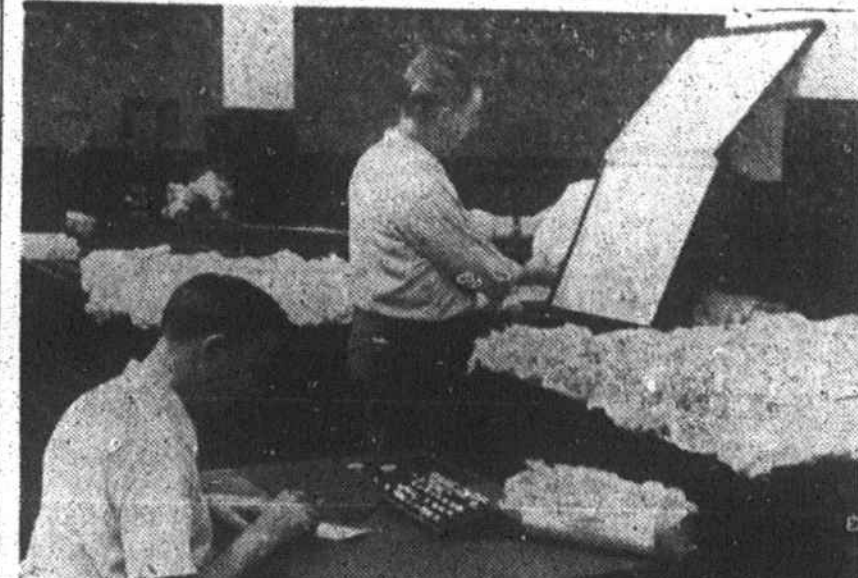

CONDUCT COTTON MARKETING MEETING

D. H. Stancil, left, cotton marketing specialist for the State College Extension Service, and H. G. Connolly, right, who is in charge of the Raleigh Cotton Classing Office, will conduct meetings on cotton marketing in Cleveland County and 12 other counties this month. Also participating will be ginning and marketing specialists for the State Department of Agriculture. County Agent Howard Clapp has announced that the meetings will be held at Shelby high school auditorium Wednesday at 10 a. m. and at the agricultural building at 7:30 p. m.

Cotton Marketing Specialists Set Meetings At Shelby On Wednesday

Is cotton "just cotton" or are there really important differences in the bales that come to market? This is one of many questions that will be answered in a series of meetings to be held in Cleveland and 12 other counties. The principal speaker will be H. G. Connolly, who is in charge of the Raleigh Cotton Classing Office and has had considerable experience in his field. Connolly is thoroughly familiar with the Universal Grade Standards and Government Sample Types, having spent considerable time in actually assisting in selecting cottons for the grade standards and assembling the cotton in the boxes. He is well known in the cotton trade, particularly since he spent a number of years selecting and buying cotton for a group of mills. He also has served as head classifier in a cotton cooperative association and has been in charge of Government Classing Offices in the West and Southwest. D. H. Stancil, cotton marketing specialist for the State College Extension Service, and ginning and marketing specialists for the State Department of Agriculture also will appear on the programs. The meetings in Cleveland County will be held Wednesday (Aug. 15) at the Shelby high school auditorium at 10 a. m. for ginners and at the agricultural building at 7:30 p. m. for farmers, according to Howard Clapp, county agent.
