### Favorite RECIPES

#### SUNLIGHT CHIFFON PIE (Lemons)

Miss Mary Boyce McGUI  
1 envelope Knox gelatin  
1/4 cup cold water  
4 eggs  
1/2 cup lemon juice  
1 cup sugar  
1 tsp. Lemon rind  
Vanilla wafers  
2 tablespoons melted butter  
Separate eggs; add 1/2 of the sugar mentioned above (1/2 cup), lemon juice and rind to beaten egg yolks and cook in double boiler until of custard consistency, stirring constantly. Soften the gelatin in the cold water and add to hot custard mixture. When mixture is cool, add stiffly beaten egg whites to which the other 1/2 cup of sugar has been added. Fill baked pie shell or vanilla wafer crust and chill. Serve with whipped cream.

**VANILLA WAFER CRUST**  
Melt butter mentioned above in pyrex pie pan. Crumble vanilla wafers in bottom of pan and place whole wafers around edges of pan. This recipe makes one large pie or 2 medium sized ones.

#### CHEWEY COOKIES (Brown Sugar)

Miss Mary Boyce McGUI  
1/2 lb. butter  
2 eggs  
1 1/4 cups flour  
1 tsp. vanilla  
1 tsp. baking powder  
1 cup pecans (or other nuts)  
2 cups brown sugar  
Cream butter and sugar, add beaten eggs. Then add flour, vanilla, and baking powder. Add nuts last.  
Bake in greased pan in slow oven about 30 minutes. Cool and cut in strips or squares. A cup of cut up dates may be substituted for nuts if preferred.

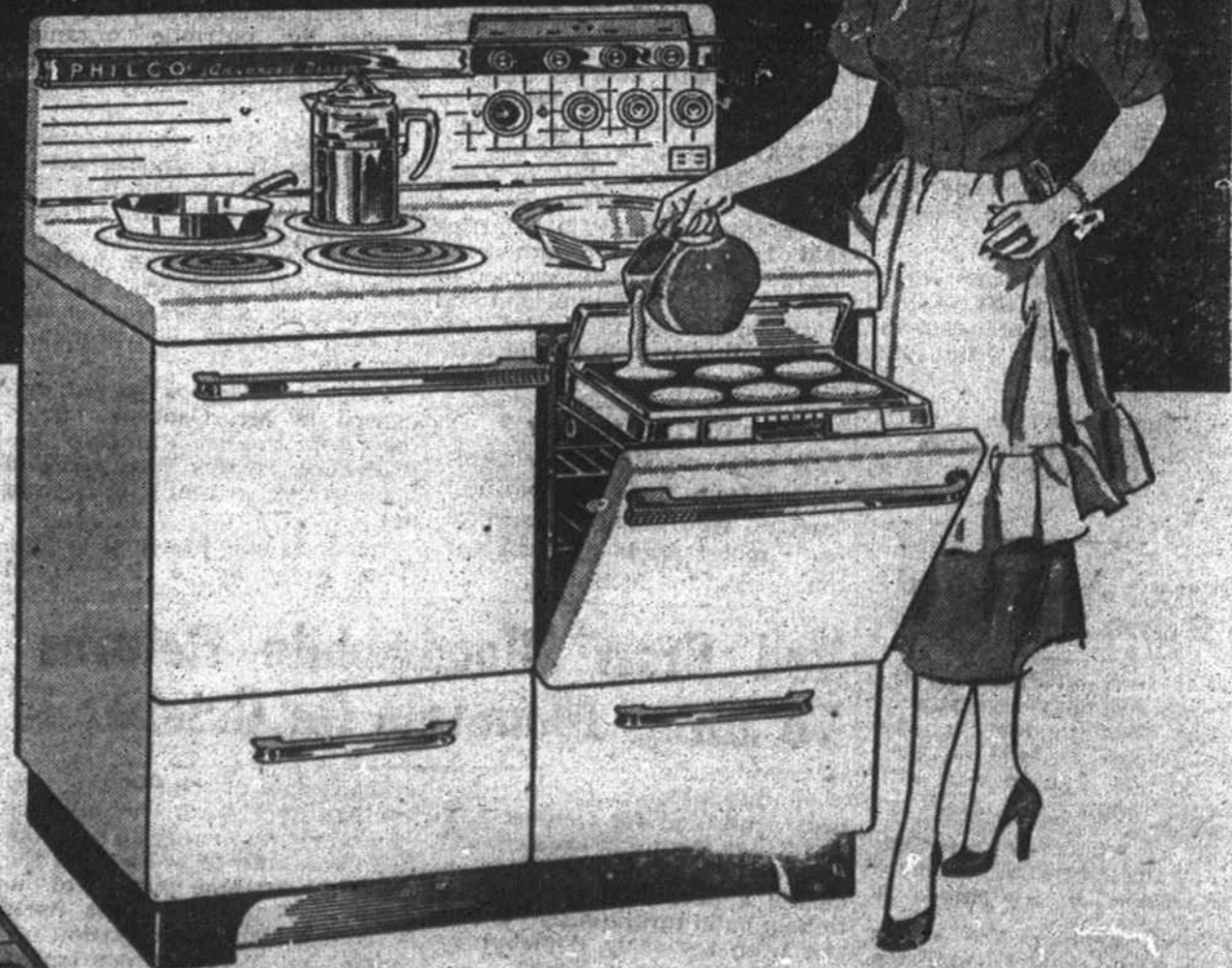
