There were 685 cases called for trial and of this number 577 were dismissed or found not guilty.

One defendant was bound over to Superior Court on a manslaughter charge while 14 counts were not pressed and three were not pressed with leave.

Other cases called were: carrying concealed weapon, 9; abandonment and non-support, 8; non-support, 8; assault with deadly weapon, 17; simple assault, 10; driving drunk, 18; driving without a driver's license, 23; reckless driving, 18; hit and run, 6; illegal possession of non-tax-paid whiskey, 27; illegal possession tax-paid whiskey, 8; illegal possession tip boards, 1; transporting, 1; larceny, 7; temporary larceny, 1; interfering with fire department, 1; interfering with an officer, 1; using profane and indecent language, 2; attempted assault with deadly weapon, 2; disposing of mortgaged property, 2; worthless checks, 7; malicious damage to property, 3; illegal possession of firecrackers, 2; failure to pay taxi fare, 5; vagrancy, 2; minor traffic violations, 28.

Parking meter violations during the year 1951 totaled 1,930 according to a report of Officer J. O. Thompson. The one dollar fine was paid by 492 and the remaining 1,438 were cancelled for various reasons or the perpetrators failed to report to the police department.
