Hinson Receives Commission

THIRD ARMY HEADQUARTERS, Atlanta, Ga. — Warrant Officer (Junior Grade) Clyde A. Hinson, son of Mrs. Margaret A. Hinson, Kings Mountain, N. C., has received an appointment in his same rank in the Organized Reserve Corps in ceremonies at Third Army Headquarters, Fort McPherson, Ga.

Under provisions of a new Department of the Army regulations, warrant officers on active duty and holding temporary warrants in the Army of the United States may, upon application, be given Reserve appointment. The ORC appointment does not terminate temporary AUS appointments now held and will not affect present duty status. The change is made possible by a new Army policy which for the first time makes provision for the grade of Warrant Officer in the Organized Reserve.

Warrant Officer Hinson, now assigned to duty with the Adjutant General's section at Third Army headquarters, attended high school at Rock Hill, S. C. He first entered the Army in 1935, and during World War II saw service in the European theatre.

He was appointed a Warrant Officer in March, 1951.
