Broiler Market Is Surfeited

RALEIGH - Commercial broiler growers in North Carolina are faced with the problem of moving more than one million broilers now of marketable size from their farms. This accumulated supply of broilers, according to Ralph B. Kelly, poultry marketing specialist with the N. C. Department of Agriculture, has resulted in a depressed market and prices paid producers at present are, in many cases, below production costs. Because of this immediate situation, Kelly has appealed to the consuming public to take advantage of the bargain prices and buy their poultry needs for several days in advance. Housewives will find retail prices of dressed and drawn poultry in their grocery stores this week ranging around 39 to 41 cents per pound. This is the first time in months that broilers have retailed at such a low price, the specialist said. And it is probably the last time that housewives will be able to find them this cheap for many months to come, he added.

Kelly also advised persons with home freezer or freezer lockers to take advantage of this once-in-a-year opportunity and stock-up on broilers. He issued a word of caution that they should place their orders in advance with their groceryman. Last year, when a similar situation occurred, many grocerymen had to turn back customers because their supplies were quickly bought by customers with home freezers and freezer lockers, he said.
