Crippled Children League To Meet

Representatives of the local chapters of the North Carolina League for Crippled Children and Adults in this county are planning to attend the annual meeting of the Society in Asheville October 12.

The program has just been announced by Albin Pikutis, executive secretary at headquarters in Chapel Hill.

Sessions, to be held at the George Vanderbilt Hotel, will be presided over by President Hilden Ramsey of Asheville.

Dr. W. T. Sanger, president of the Medical College of Virginia, who is president of the national society, will be the principal speaker. He will talk on "Team Work for Crippled Children."

The meeting will open with a get-together dinner at 7 p. m. Wednesday, October 1, to be followed by a business session of the board of directors.

Registration for the general session will begin at 9 a. m. Thursday, October 2. Awards for outstanding service to the handicapped will precede the presentation of the 1953 Easter Sale chairman.

A demonstration of the work being done at the Asheville Prep-School for Handicapped Children, including the showing of a film, "Operation Improvement," made at the center, will be the major attraction of the afternoon session. Time will be set aside for questions and discussion of how the best results may be obtained in such a preschool. Dr. Stanley S. Atkins, Asheville, will coordinate this demonstration.

The staff of the school and volunteers from the Junior League of Asheville, who have directed the school's development, will give the observations and experiences they have encountered.

At 4 p. m. there will be a Parent Council meeting. The Council will be made up of representatives from the 10 Parent Study groups which are a vital part of the society's chapters. This group will act as a guiding influence on future planning for handicapped children in North Carolina.

The interested public, especially parents of handicapped children, is invited to attend all sessions.

Officers of the Society this year, in addition to President Ramsey, are Thomas O'Brien, Goldsboro, honorary president; Paul Butler, Southern Pines, vice-president; Dr. C. C. Crittendon, Raleigh, vice-president; Mrs. Joe W. Shuford, Hickory, secretary, and W. E. Thompson, Chapel Hill, secretary.
