A recent survey in North Carolina's Coastal Plains shows that loans obtained from banks cost \$6.51 per \$100 loaned; from Production Credit Associations, \$6.55, from the Farmers Home Administration, \$5.47, and from private sources other than commercial banks, \$14 per \$100 loaned.

In 1930 there were 380,549 mules and horses in North Carolina. By 1940 the number was down only slightly to 374,468, and by 1950 to 355,077.

The trend on North Carolina farms is toward more owners and away from tenants.

Farmers can obtain Commodity Credit Corporation loans to finance the purchase of drying equipment for the conditioning of storage crops.

In 1940 it took the American farmer 47 hours to produce a bushel of wheat; now it takes only 31 hours.
