## **Two Bound Over To High Court**

Bobby Gene Guin, 20, and Jerome Grant, 15, were bound over to Superior court from Recorder's court Monday.

The two defendants had admitted breaking into Robert's Grocery Store Sunday and taking about 15 cartons of cigarettes, some Vienna sausages and loaves of bread.

Charges of larceny of an auto-mobile were also placed against the two boys by Chief Hugh Lo-gan, Jr. Chief Logan said that the boys admitted that they stole a 1951 Pontiac from the lot of Dean Builde Converse This were the Buck Company. This was the car the boys parked on Linwood Road while the boys entered the grocery store.

A charge of attempting to break and enter was filed against the pair on their confessions that they tried to break into Putnam's Fruit Stand on Cleveland Avenue. They said a police car drove in and scared them away on this attempt.

Chief Logan also said that Guin had admitted that he stole a 1949 Pontiac in Roanoke Rapids, N. C., and drove it to Kings Mountain, finally abandoning it at Bethware school.

Guin waived preliminary hearing and was bound over to Su-perior court by Judge Jack White. able cause against the younger defendant and bound him over also.

A total bond of \$2,500 was set for each of the defendants on the three charges.

Grant was reported to have already been out on a \$500 bond set in another case involving the theft of a truck from a local business firm. This case is also set to be heard in Superior court.

A Kings Mountain man found himself in a funny situation Sunday when he came into City Hall to swear out a warrant for a man. who he said had stolen a watch and some money from him.

The man who claimed to have been robbed found himself charged with public drunkenness, since he was slightly under the influence at the time he was taking out the warrant.

The defendant told Judge White that he was coming in to give himself up at the same time he was asking for the warrant. The court found him guilty and

gave him a 30-day suspended sen-tence, and fined him the costs of

court. Marion Froneberger and Essie Lee Roseboro, Kings Mountain Negroes, were involved in a case that took up a good portion of

the court's one-hour session. Marion was charged with using profane and indecent language in a warrant signed by Essie Lee On the other hand, Essie Lee was accused of assault in a warrant taken out by Marion.

The warrant against Marior Froneberger was improperly drawn and a new warrant charging her with disorderly conduct in a public place was prepared while


