

War Orphans Can Obtain **School Aid**

President Eisenhower signed a bill on June 29, 1956 which a-wards \$110 monthly up to thirtysix months while the child of a serviceman or veteran of World War I, II or Korean Conflict is attending school, providing the parent's death was the resultl of service. A child, for these bene. fits, means a legitimate child, or child legally adopted by the parent and so forth, who is less than twenty-three years old on June 29, 1956. Being married is not a bar to these benefits. These payments are effective from Oc. tober 1, 1956 for those applicants who are attending school.

These benefits are for use usually while attending business, trade, vocational schools, or colleges above secondary school level. Schooling above the usual four years of college degree may be obtained under this law. Also, there may be vocational rehabilitation in specialized schools or on job training offered where the child is determined to be vocationally handicapped.

Due to the procedure to be followed by applicants entering schools and institutions to obtain these benefits, the eligible person should apply immediately to the County Veterans' Service Of-ficer, Chalmus L. Miller or the office of the North Carolina Veterans Commission, Ervin Building, Morganton,


