The hearings will begin at 2:00 p. m. on Monday, August 3, in the City Council Chamber of the Statesville City Hall and the public is cordially invited to attend the meeting.

The regular monthly business session of the Highway Commission will be held the following morning in Statesville.

The August hearing will be the 30th such meeting held by the full Commission during the past 24 months. Similar opportunities have been given citizens to air their road requests before all the Commissioners in hearings which have ranged from Murphy in the west to Manteo in the east.

Legislation approved by the 1959 General Assembly permits the Commission to move freely about the State with hearings and regular business meetings. Hereafter, the Commission was required to be in Raleigh for at least one meeting each 60 days.
