Bond Sales Are Climbing

The people of North Carolina responded to the higher interest rate of 3 3/4 percent now being paid on Savings Bonds by increasing their purchases. During October, statewide sales of Savings Bonds, Series E and Series H combined were up 6.3 per cent over sales of last October.

The Series H bonds showed the strongest increase, with sales being 23.6 per cent greater than they were in the same month of a year ago. Series E bonds were up 4.6 per cent.

Cumulative sales for the year amounted to \$38,750,065. This is 76 per cent of North Carolina's 1959 goal of \$51,000,000.

Cleveland County sales for October were \$51,090.85 bringing the total sales for the year to \$296,971.75.

Six counties have already achieved their sales quota for 1959. They are Dare, Henderson, Hoke, Macon, Pamlico and Swain.
