Transco Company Gets Achievement

Men of the Transco Compressor Station No. 34 near Kings Mountain, along with men of Transco Compressor Station No. 15 at Davidson, were honored for an accident-free year in 1959 at recent achievement award ceremonies at Davidson.

Open house and barbecue featured the program. R. S. Bruns, vice-president of marketing, made the principal address. Officers and department heads from the Houston, Texas headquarters of Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company attended.

Mr. Bruns commented, "Since 1960 is Transco's 10th year of operations it is appropriate to review the progress we have made since gas was first sold in January, 1951. In the past nine years we have invested more than \$400,000,000, so that our total plant at the beginning of this year was valued at 2 3/4 times the investment with which we started sales. Our operating revenues have increased more than \$100,000,000 and our pipe line capacity has increased more than 2 3/4 times the original 505 million cubic feet daily.

"1959 was another year of significant growth and progress. 51 miles of 30" and 36" loop lines were laid and 23,640 horsepower were added to existing compres-

sor stations. Our third underwater crossing was completed into New York City, where we serve nearly 90 percent of the natural gas market. The Leidy storage field in Pennsylvania was activated, including 133 miles of 24" line connecting it to the main system. More than 400 miles of purchase laterals in and offshore Louisiana were completed. This construction program required expenditures of more than \$69,000,000 during the year.

"Volumes of gas sold and transported during 1959 increased 23 percent over 1958 and new daily peaks were established earlier this year. Pipe line throughput during February, 1960, averaged more than 1 billion cubic feet daily.

"As a result of this increased capacity and also due, to some extent to increased rates collected subject to refund beginning November 18, 1959, operating revenues were \$147,000,000 during the year, of 27 percent more than 1958. Earnings per share on the
