**Fiber Plans**

**New Plant In Greenville**

Greenville, S. C. — Fiber Industries, Inc. announced today that it has selected a 200 acre tract near Greenville, South Carolina as the site for its new plant for the manufacture of Nylon 66 yarn.

Peter H. Conze, Chairman of Fiber Industries said that initial construction work at the Greenville site, which is located on interstate highway 85, about six miles southeast of the city hall will start during the week of October 20.

Fiber Industries organized originally in 1958 as a company owned 50 percent each by Celanese and Imperial Chemical Industries, Ltd., of Great Britain, has been producing polyester fiber at its Shelby, North Carolina plant. Plans recently announced provide for Celanese to own 62 1/2 percent of Fiber Industries with I. C. I. to own 25 percent, and the remaining 12 1/2 percent to be held by British Nylon Spinners Limited also of Great Britain.

The Nylon 66 yarn plant at commercial production in 1965, Greenville is expected to begin with an initial capacity of 40 million pounds per year. The yarn will be marketed by Celanese Fibers Company, which also markets Fiber Industries' polyester fiber under the trademark Fortrel. The nylon yarn will be marketed for apparel, carpet, tire cord and industrial applications.

Mr. Conze pointed out that the interchange of technical knowledge and operating know-how with I. C. I. and British Nylon Spinners not only provides Fiber Industries with an extensive background of experience in the manufacture of Nylon 66, but also will expand the Celanese fibers line, which currently includes four other major man-made fibers... acetate, rayon, Arnel triacetate and Fortrel polyester.

Mr. Kimbrell had lived in the Mt. Paran community for 18 years. He was a member of the Mt. Paran Baptist church and was employed by Wendell Plastics of Blacksburg.

Other survivors include his wife, two sons, four brothers, two sisters and eight grandchildren.

**Quarterly Returns Should Be Filed**

Quarterly social security tax returns must be filed with the District Director of Internal Revenue by the end of October for the previous three months, Lex G. Barkley, Social Security Administration District Manager in Gastonia, reminded employers today.

It is important that social security tax returns be filed on time and that they be complete. They must show the correct amount of earnings paid each worker during the quarter and his correct name and social security number. Otherwise, the worker and his family may not be fully protected in the event of the worker's disability, retirement, or death.

Earnings of employees of a business must be reported each quarter regardless of the amount of wages paid. Cash wages of domestic employees and other household workers must be reported by each employer who pays cash wages of \$50 or more to an employee during the calendar quarter.

Employers who have questions about their quarterly social security reports, or have need for tax reporting forms, should get in touch with their Internal Revenue Service office. Questions regarding social Security benefits or other information on social should be directed to the nearest Social Security Administration office.

Here are authoritative answers by the Veterans Administration to questions from former servicemen and their families:

**Q**—As a so-called peacetime veteran, am I entitled to any service connected disability compensation from the VA?

**A**—Yes, such disability compensation is generally 80 percent of the wartime rates. However, if the disability occurred under extraordinary conditions or simulating wartime; i.e., service in Viet Nam, wartime rates apply.
