

# **Farmers Favor Nickel Program**

Tar Heel farmers nave ex pressed their continued willingness to support agricultural re-search at North Carolina State by giving the Nickels for Know-How program another over whelming vote of approval.
Official tabulations of the No

vember 19 vote showed that 51,-282 voted for the assessment and only 5,759 against. This is a favorable vote of 89.9 per cent of those participating well over the two-thirds majority necessary to reapprove the program.

The vote was strongly in favor in all 100 counties. The total vote of 57.011 is the

largest since the program drew slightly over 61,000 voters to the pools in the initial referendum held in 1951. The latest referendum marks the fifth time North Carolina us-

ers of fertilizer and feed have given their strong support to the unique program.

Under its provisions, the farmer pays a nickel extra for each ton of feed and fertilizer he buys.
