May Has News For Seniors

Local U. S. Air Force Recruiting Sergeant May had good news today for college seniors. He reported that it is now possible for them to complete their application for Air Force Officers Training School and enter class in the month of their choice following graduation.

The Air Force Officers Training School is a three month course of instruction leading to a commission as Second Lieutenant in the USAF. Open to both men and women college graduates, it has become — in the short span of three years — the largest source of Air Force officers.

Men and women college graduates under the age of 30 may apply for this program at the local Air Force Recruiting Office. Women should be single and without dependants under the age of 18 but there are no marital or dependency restrictions for men.

Sergeant May also pointed out that it is possible to take all necessary mental and physical examinations for Air Force Officers Training School without obligation of any kind. And now this fastest route to a commission offered by any branch of the armed forces is open to college seniors.
