Light Docket Aired Monday In City Court

A light docket of cases were heard before Recorder's Court Judge Jack White Monday.

Frankie Moore, 19-year-old Negro, of Route 2, pled guilty to six charges of motor vehicle violations. Moore was found guilty of operating a motor vehicle without securing proper insurance, failure to stop for a siren, no operator's license, a stop light violation, displaying an improper license plate, and speeding 70 in a 35 mile zone. He was sentenced to 60 days suspended upon the payment of a \$30 fine and the costs of court in the case of no insurance and failure to stop for a siren; received a 30 day sentence suspended upon the payment of a \$25 fine and the costs of court in the case of no operator's license; and 90 days suspended upon the payment of a \$25 fine and the costs of court in the case of a stop light violation, improper tag, and speeding 70 in a 35 mile zone. His driver's license was revoked for a period of two years. The three sentences were to run consecutively.
