

Routine Docket Aired Monday In City Court




Friends, today we are approaching the closing hours of the campaign.

Divide this figure by the number of square feet a gallon of paint covers, as stated on the label. This gives you the frac-tion of a gallon needed to paint the radiator. Remember, however, to paint the radiator on a day when you can turn it off.






