'64 World 600 Sets Record

Charlotte Motor Speedway's fifth annual World 600 late model auto race established another record crowd for a sports event in North Carolina with an attendance of 68,311.

The previous record was set by the 1963 World 600 race at 58,722.

Earl Kelley, speedway promotions director, said the 1964 race held on May 24th, showed a record day attendance increase of 8,589, or 14.9 per cent above the 1963 attendance.

Gross income for the race, Kelley said, was \$372,639 as compared with \$489,166 for the previous year. The income, Kelley added, was up 17 per cent.

The speedway recently spent more than \$110,000 on track improvements, including removal of the outskirts of Gastonia.
