Many New '65 Model Fords Now On Market

Ford will introduce new models for 1965 in dealer showrooms Friday, September 25th.

Entering its second decade, the 1965 Thunderbird continues its styling and engineering leadership with such advanced features as front wheel disc brakes, standard equipment on all models. Other 1965 Thunderbird standard equipment owner-benefit features include distinctive sequential turn signals which create a light pattern in the turning direction, reversible keys which may be inserted into ignition and trunk locks either side up, keyless door locking, and a dome light on convertible models.

New or revised options include an AM/FM operation, on electric antenna, power vent windows, a vacuum deck lid release, and limited slip differential.

The three 1965 Thunderbird models—landau, convertible and hardtop—will debut in Ford dealer showrooms Friday, September 25th.

A third Mustang model—the 2 plus 2 fastback—joins hardtop and convertible Mustangs announced as the first of its 1965 cars by Ford Division last April. The new Mustang provides seating for four. Fold-down rear seats permit added luggage-included skis and other lengthy equipment—to be carried inside the car with driver and passenger.

Functional air louvers styled into the rear roof quarter-panels provide an efficient, flow-through ventilation system for window-up driving free from wind noises and drafts in nearly all kinds of weather. Continued as standard equipment on all Mustangs are such sports and luxury features as bucket seats, molded nylon carpeting, floor mounted shift for both manual and automatic transmissions, all vinyl interior, padded instrument panel, and full wheel covers.

Improved performance with increased fuel economy for gas savings up to 15 per cent have been achieved in the tastefully restyled Ford Falcon for 1965.

Wheat Sign-Up Deadline Near

The fall group sign-up for the 1965 wheat diversion program is now in progress. Farmers who have not already filed their intention under the 1965 wheat program are urged to do so.

Wheat farmers must file their intentions before October 2. Intentions will not be accepted after that date; however, they may revise their intentions providing they request the revision before the close of the spring sign-up period for feed grains.

4-H Week Observance Set

Throughout the United States, 4-H'ers will observe National 4-H Club Week, Sept. 26 through Oct. 3. The head-heart-hands-health youth are among 2 1/2 million members of 91,700 clubs in urban, suburban, and rural areas throughout the 50 states and Puerto Rico.

With the goal of "4-H for more in '64," current emphasis is on the program's flexibility—club projects and activities adaptable to fit needs of youth from any background or circumstance.

Dr. Carlton Blalock, state 4-H leader, says this is the time that 4-H'ers take a look at their accomplishments for the year and make a report of their progress to the people in North Carolina.

Blalock says it also provides an opportunity for the 4-H'ers to say "thank you" to more than 20,000 volunteer adult leaders who play a vital role in the lives of these young people and to over a 1,000 business concerns who serve as sponsors of some phase of the program.

According to Blalock, there is still a need for leaders—even those who can afford to devote only a small amount of time. Long-range plans call for more than doubling the present number of leaders to adequately serve the young people.

A major local and national aim of this year's 4-H Week observance will be to recognize the 50th anniversary of the Cooperative Extension Service, of which the 4-H youth program is a significant part. In 1914, when the Smith-Lever Act authorized the Extension Service, the same federal legislation provided funds for 4-H Club work. For this reason, also, celebrates a Golden Anniversary.

Special 4-H Week activities planned for North Carolina include special newspaper editions highlighting local 4-H activities;

radio and television stations will feature 4-H news; special recognition banquets will be held for leaders and sponsors; some 90 roadside billboard posters will be displayed along the highways; special programs at civic club meetings.
