News items this week from Richmond, Carteret, Northampton, Davidson, Polk and Henderson Counties.

HAND PAINTED COOKIES
Wonder what's cooking in Richmond County kitchens these days? Mrs. Martha Adams, home economics agent, says homemakers are busy preparing holiday foods ahead of time and storing them in the freezer.

"You don't have to be an artist to decorate fancy cookies sliced from a roll of frozen cookie dough," explains Mrs. Adams. "To hand paint cookies, add food coloring to egg yolk and paint simple designs with an ordinary water color brush. Use individual custard cups and paint brushes for each color. Pop the cookie sheet in the oven and in a few minutes you have hand painted cookies ready for the holiday season."

EDUCATIONAL EXHIBITS
Four exhibits were featured at the Carteret County Home Demonstration Clubs achievement day program. Mrs. Floy Garner, home economics agent, says the public was invited to visit the exhibits on foods, clothing, house furnishings and Christmas gifts. Mrs. Milton Piner and Mrs. B. O. Ketner, county clothing leaders, took turns in the clothing booth giving demonstrations on making blond button holes and putting in zippers.

RELAXING HOBBY
Homemakers in Northampton County have not found that knitting is a relaxing hobby. Mrs. Audrey Jenkins, home economics agent, says that at the last county-wide workshop, some 12-15 women, were knitting on sweaters.

These leaders are now planning to conduct knitting workshops in their local communities.

YUM, YUM, YAMS
How many ways do you prepare sweet potatoes in your menus? Home Demonstration Club women in Davidson County report a renewed interest in "yams" as a result of the demonstration given by leaders emphasizing the use of sweet potatoes. The versatility of the "high in vitamin A" product was stressed at the meetings.

Mrs. Martha Thompson, home economics agent, says many of the hostesses for the meetings served a sweet potato dessert.

MAKE YOUR OWN BEDSPREAD
If you are interested in making a bedspread to go with special furnishings in a bedroom, you may want to make your own.

Miss Eloise Thompson, assistant home economics agent, says the Polk County Home Demonstration Club members observed several different types of spreads — tufted, woven, coverlet and quilt, and tailored or dress-maker.

ALL ABOUT CREDIT
What do you really know about credit? How much does it actually cost you? Mrs. Nell Garrison, home economics agent, reports that Henderson County homemakers have been studying what credit is, what is cost and why where and how to borrow or buy on time, and how to be smart about using credit.
