

W Films Available

Produced by the North Carolina Film Board are now available for adult use through the public libraries of the State.

Today by H. V. Anderson, Audio-Visual Consultant, North Carolina State Library. Six films available to date are:

THE EYES HAVE IT, a 38-minute black & white film showing the 1963 North Carolina General Assembly at work in general sessions, committee sessions and rump sessions in hotel rooms. Members of the General

Assembly are followed through these various sessions, to meetings with lobbyists, and home for meetings with their constituents. Scenes of the new Legislative Building are included.

ROAD TO CAROLINA 30 minutes, the story of North Carolina's first 100 years of Colonial history in color combining the use of portraits, drawings, and actual shots of historic locations.

THE VANISHING FRONTIER 58 minutes in black & white, shows the problems to be overcome in combating the poverty of the Appalachian Region of the State. An optimistic film, it shows the progress made in those communities now served by new roads, better schools, and new

industry. **MIRROR OF THE PAST**, 28 minutes in color showing the gardens and treasures and telling the history of Tryon's Palace in New Bern. **WELCOME TO WORK**, a black

and white 28-minute industrial development film telling how Siler City brought new industry and progress to town.

NORTH CAROLINA'S TRIBUTE TO PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, a 29-minute color documentary of the memorial program on May 17, 1964 in Chapel Hill's Kenan Stadium. Speakers include among others Governor Terry Sanford, former Governor and present U. S. Secretary of Commerce Luther Hodges, and Evangelist Billy Graham.

Program planners note: request the film or films at least two weeks or more in advance; ask about other films offered by the North Carolina Adult Film Project.
