Boy Scouts Make Report To President

Explorer Vidar Jorgensen of Post 365, sponsored by Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company of Shelby and 11 other Scouts and Explorers who delivered the official 1964 report of the Boy Scouts of America to President Johnson and other government leaders yesterday continued their reporting activities today as they represented the organization's 5,585,700 members during Boy Scout Week, February 7-13.

At a "Logger's Breakfast" given by the American Forest Products Industries, Curtis E. Frye, 16, of Fergus Falls, Minn., reported for the group on Scouting's many conservation activities and presented the new "Emergency Preparedness" handbook dealing with handling natural and man-made disasters.

The group toured the State Department where Louis A. Tally, 17, of Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio, reported to Undersecretary of State for Political Affairs W. Averell Harriman on World Scouting, exchanges with foreign Scouts, and some plans for the 1967 World Jamboree to be held in the United States.

Associate Supreme Court Justice Tom Clark, one of the nation's first Eagle Scouts, arranged a luncheon at the Court, and Associate Justice Byron R. White hosted for Justice Clark. Spokesman was George L. Priest, 16, Lakewood, Col.

Sargent Shriver, Director of the Office of Economic Opportunity, received the group and Ronald D. Pogue, 16, of Houston Texas, reported on the ways Scouting's new "Breakthrough for Youth" ties in with the War on Poverty.

At the Civil Service Commission, Mark S. Hockberg, 16, of Providence, R. I., reported to Chairman John W. Macy on cooperative efforts in expanding Scouting.

J. Edgar Hoover, Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, received the report on "Breakthrough for Youth" from James H. Pooley, 16, of Wilmington, Del.

Tonight the Report Scouts go to New York where they report to the United Nations Secretary General U. Thant and continue their activities through Friday (12).
