HOMEMAKERS MARKET
 Making jam needn't mean getting into one. Richmond County homemakers hope that making jam will become a profitable hobby, reports Mrs. Martha Adams, home economics agent.

Members of the Dogwood Home Demonstration Club are planning to open a "Homemakers Market" just before Christmas. Homemade products, which are suitable for gifts, will be on display. They are making jellies and packaging seed and bulbs from their garden.

CLUB MEMBERS REACH GOAL
 Homemakers in the Providence Home Demonstration Club in Pasquotank County have reached a long-time goal. They purchased a lot, an old store building, and are now remodeling the store into a club house. Miss Edna Bishop, home economics agent, says the club members, husbands, and friends have all worked on the building. "In this restoration project some members painted, some sewed and others cleaned, but all were involved," adds Miss Bishop.

FREEZING FOODS
 When you do not have a freezer of your own, a 4-H'er can make money and complete a project in food-preservation anyway. Believes Betty Craig of Rutherford County.

Miss Mildred Stallings, home economics agent, says Betty has two pressure canners and two hotwater canners and cans more than 700 quarts of food each year. She assists the neighbors in freezing foods too.

HOUSE FURNISHINGS MADE
 Samples of bedspreads, home made sheets, home trimmer sheets, wall hangings, braider rugs, quilts, monogrammed towels, and antiques furniture have been on display in Iredell County.

Mrs. Nancy Myers, home economics agent, says the purpose of the house furnishings display has been to encourage homemakers and young girls to use inexpensive materials, creative ideas and their own skill in beautifying their home.

UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE
 Mrs. H. T. White in Tyrrell County learned to upholster furniture in a Home Demonstration workshop several years ago. Now she has decided to assist her daughter in going to college by going into the upholstery business.

According to Mrs. Ann Davert, home economics agent, Mrs. White is not only working for herself but has served as leader and taught in several leader workshops.

NATURALIZATION CEREMONY
 Three members of the Home Demonstration Club in Davidson County prepared the Bible for presentation to the new citizens at the June naturalization ceremony in Greensboro. Mrs. Martha Thompson, home economics agent, says the citizenship leaders find this one of the

Summer Theatre Is Featuring "Carousel"

The Charlotte Summer Theater production of the Rodgers and Hammerstein musical hit, "Carousel", starring Bill Hayes, opened Tuesday evening, and runs through Sunday afternoon, July 11 at Owens Auditorium in Charlotte.

Bill Hayes, the handsome singing star of "Carousel", is returning for his second engagement with the Charlotte Summer Theater; he scored a solid hit here in "Oklahoma" two summers ago. Hayes began his career on television and went on to become a top theater, television and recording star. His hit record of "The Ballad of Davy Crockett" sold 2,000,000 copies. His stage credits include starring roles in such musicals as "A Tree Grows in Brooklyn", "Me and Juliet", "Bye, Bye, Birdie" and "South Pacific".

"Carousel" has become one of America's favorite musicals since it first opened on Broadway in 1945. The beloved Rodgers and Hammerstein score includes such all-time favorites as "If I Loved You", "June Is Bustin' Out All Over", "Soliloquy", "What's the Use of Wond'rin'?" and "You'll Never Walk Alone". The liltting musical, set in a New England fishing village, tells the bitter-sweet story of Billy Bigelow, carnival barker, and his romance with Julie Jordan. In song and dance, "Carousel" follows their life together from their first meeting, their courtship and marriage, the birth of their daughter, and Billy's striving for his wife and daughter. "Carousel" was its enduring popularity to the skillful blend of Richard Rodgers' bright and beautiful musical score and Oscar Hammerstein's lyrics and script, at once tender and funny, with lavish scenery, exciting dances and soaring chorus numbers.

Mara Worth is featured as Julie Jordan in "Carousel" opposite Bill Hayes. Also featured in the cast are Geoffrey Webb, Lois Ann Saunders, Grant Eastham, Fred Vinroot, Carole Love and Bonnie Ann.

Performances for "Carousel" are at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday evenings and at 2:30 p.m. for the Saturday and Sunday matinees, July 10 and 11.

The next attraction at the Charlotte Summer Theater is "A Funny Thing Happened On The Way To The Forum" starring Phi. Poster July 13 through July 18.

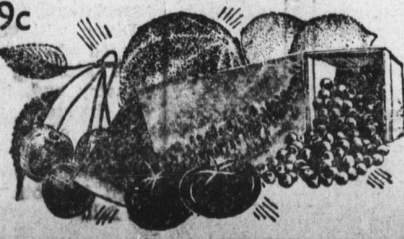
