Art Films Are Available

Art films available from the North Carolina State Library, Raleigh, include those describing great periods in art history as well as those that are photographic works of art in themselves. Some recently added films in this category are:

THE ACROPOLIS—a description of the architectural and sculptural details of the great acropolis in Athens, Greece.
THE AGE OF THE ROCOCO—a molding of music, art, architecture, costume, and literature

to give the viewer a total feeling of the Rococo period in history.
THE ANCIENT EGYPTIAN—a history of ancient Egypt through use of pictures of the Nile and its temples.
GIUSEPPINA—an international prize winning film that pictures a day in the life of a little Italian girl.
OCCURRENCE AT OWL CREEK BRIDGE—a dramatization of the Civil War story by Ambrose Bierce—another international prize winner.
TOCATTI FOR TOY TRAINS—a film for railroad buffs and collectors of toys.
WHALE OF NEW BEDFORD—a chronicle of a whaling voyage that is told through use of a painting 1300 feet long at the whaling museum in New Bedford, Mass.
These films are recent additions to the North Carolina Adult Film Project—a collection of 16mm films owned by all public libraries of North Carolina. H. V. Anderson, director of the project, suggests that requests for any of these films be made at your public library at least two weeks prior to the time they will be used. These films are not available for use in the public schools. This is a free public library service.
