Getting jars to seal perfectly is a must in home canning, agrees Mrs. Jassiephine Chamblee, Harrellsville, Rt. 1. She echoes these tips from Mrs. Clara Y. Motley, home economics extension agent, Hertford County. To make sure you have a perfect seal (1) examine jars carefully before using. Discard those with chips or cracks; (2) follow the manufacturer's directions for using tops, lids or other closures; (3) do not re-use self-seal metal lids and rubber rings, and (4) use tongs for removing jars from canner after processing. Leave jars in upright position.
