Insurance Facts Given

"Where can I find out about what my health insurance under social security covers?" This is a question frequently asked to day. An excellent source of information is the reference book which has been supplied to every beneficiary. It is the green Medicare Handbook which is divided into two sections, one covering hospital insurance, the other medical insurance.

The first section explains in detail the important role of the health insurance card, how hospital insurance works, inpatient hospital benefits, extended care and home health benefits after hospitalization, outpatient diagnostic benefits, a "spell of illness," some frequently asked questions and answers, and how hospital insurance benefits are financed.
