## Kingdom Hall Dedication Set At Crouse

The Lincoln congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses announced plans today for the dedication of their newly constructed Kingdom Hall in Crouse. A program of special activity is planned for November 23 and 24.

Dedication ceremonies will be conducted by a special traveling supervisor from Brooklyn, N. Y.; J. D. Sawyer. Also on the program will be a history of the work of the Lincoln congregation and a slide illustrated presentation on the construction of the building.

"This Kingdom Hall was built with the volunteer assistance of our own members", Jerry Gibby, presiding minister said. The actual construction of the white masonry sided building began last February 9.

"It is our hope to make Kingdom Hall a center for true worship in this community, contributing to the spiritual uplift and welfare of our area", he commented.

Jehovah's Witnesses from a wide area of western North Carolina and parts of South Carolina are expected to attend. "We will have open house on both Saturday and Sunday", Mr. Gibby said, "and the public is welcome to not only visit the building but to attend any and all sessions planned for the dedication."

Mr. Gibby concluded by saying that all meetings of Jehovah's Witnesses at the Kingdom Hall are free and no collections are ever taken. The construction cost of the work of Jehovah's Witnesses is supported through voluntary contributions.
