**PAY ATTENTION**

Announcement time at a meeting is not the time to let your mind wander. Instead give announcements your rapt attention, advises Mrs. Louise Patterson, a homemaker from Robeson County.

Last spring, while attending an Extension Homemakers meeting, Mrs. Patterson heard Mrs. Mollye H. Briley, home economics Extension agent, mention a series of cake decorating classes available at a nearby technical institute.

Mrs. Patterson added, "I took this course and now average an additional \$25 a week decorating cakes."

"You would have to know Mrs. Patterson's circumstances to really understand how much this additional \$100 a month means to her family," the agent adds.

**TOUCH OF SPRING**

Members of Extension Homemakers Clubs in Dare County have found a way to add a touch of spring to a cold, wintry day, reports Mrs. Harriett M. Gray, home economics Extension agent.

These ladies have been making tissue paper flowers. "The flowers are fairly easy to prepare and are very colorful when created into an attractive arrangement," the agent points out.

**FACTS ABOUT FANS**

Studies have shown that as much as 200 pounds of grease-laden moisture are given off every year in the average kitchen, says Mrs. Martha B. Adams, home economics Extension agent, Richmond County.

Removal of this moisture with proper exhaust fans can save hundreds of dollars in cleaning and repair bills, she adds.

Members of Extension Homemakers Clubs in Richmond County recently visited local dealers to study the various types of home exhaust fans.

They learned that the hood mounted fan which is ducted to the outside, not only carries off odors and grease, but heat and moisture as well. Non-ducted hood fans use a system of filters to clean the air and return it to the room, but they do not remove heat and moisture.

**KNOW-HOW MAKES THE DIFFERENCE**

Mrs. Donna Coble, an Alamance County homemaker, has found sewing much easier and interesting after attending a workshop.

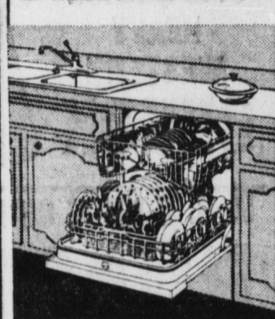
